17	A first Trial Management Conference (TMC-1) will be set for approximately		
18	four weeks prior to trial. A Trial Management Conference Report must be filed five

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## **B. DESIGNATED TRANSCRIPTS AND DISCOVERY RESPONSES**

Parties are to file designated transcripts of testimony of unavailable witnesses, discovery responses from previous cases, and objections thereto, as follows:

- All transcripts of deposition testimony, transcripts of trial testimony, and discovery responses from previous cases must be filed in the following format:
  - a. All designations are to be submitted in a black binder. Numbered tabs are to be used to separate the transcripts or volumes of transcripts. If a transcript has multiple volumes, the tab number is to match the volume number of the transcript. If there is more than one transcript for a particular witness, all of the transcripts for that witness are to be submitted in the same binder, space permitting.
  - b. An index is to be included at the front of the binder that indicates the tab number and the transcript following each tab contained in the binder.
  - c. Exhibits referred to in the testimony are to be attached at the end of each transcript. If there is more than one volume of the transcript, the exhibits referred to in a particular volume are to be included at the end of that volume.

2. Counsel must meet and confer regarding objections to the designated testimony before submitting any objections to the court. If this court has ruled on objections to a designation in a previous case, counsel are to refer to these rulings in their meet and confer discussions. Counsel are advised that, in previous cases, in ruling on objections to designations, this court *generally* found evidence regarding other asbestos-containing products may be relevant to issues of notice and/or state-of-the art, and evidence regarding post-exposure conduct may be relevant to allegations of failure to warn, retrofit, or recall, although such evidence may be subject to an Evidence Code Section 352 analysis.

- 3. The designated testimony and the objections thereto must be filed no later than fourteen (14) days after the TMC-1. The format for the objection is to be the same format required for objections filed on a motion for summary judgment, as set out in Rule 3.1354 of the California Rules of Court. A courtesy copy of the objections must also be submitted at that time.
- 4. No <u>amended</u> "objection pleading" may be filed without specific approval of the court.
- 5. Counter-designations, if any, must be filed no later than five (5) days after the date the court issues its rulings on the objections to the original designations.
- 6. An "objection pleading" to counter-designations, if any, must be filed at least five (5) days after the date the counter-designations are filed.

## C. MOTIONS IN LIMINE

All motions in limine (except those arising from expert discovery) must be filed as part of Exhibit 11 of the Trial Management Conference Report pursuant to Solano County Superior Court Local Rule No. 4.10b. A courtesy copy of each motion in limine is to be submitted to the court separate from the Trial Management Conference report at that time. All oppositions to motions in limine must be filed no later than ten (10) days after the TMC-1.

D. EXHIBIT LISTS

Counsel must meet and confer in person regarding their exhibit lists and reduce the number of exhibits to be used at trial to a reasonable amount prior to the TMC-2. Counsel are to advise the court at the TMC-2 of any objections to exhibits about which they cannot agree. The court will conduct a hearing to rule on the objections.

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## E. POWERPOINT PRESENTATIONS

2 Counsel must exchange the PowerPoint presentations they intend to use 3 at trial no later than 72 hours prior to the commencement of jury selection. Counsel 4 are to meet and confer in person regarding their objections to the PowerPoint presentation of another party, and advise the court of any objections about which they cannot agree within 48 hours of the commencement of jury selection. The court will conduct a hearing to rule on the objections.

## F. EXCLUSION OF EVIDENCE

9 Pursuant to Solano County Superior Court Rule 4.10c, the testimony of 10 witnesses who are not listed in the Trial Management Conference Report, and 11 documents, exhibits, portions of depositions, answers to interrogatories or 12 responses to requests for admissions, which are not listed in the Trial Management 13 Conference Report, shall not be admitted at trial unless the court rules, in its discretion and upon a showing of good cause, that they may be admitted despite 14 15 their omission from the Trial Management Conference Report.
