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1 going the way you're going. I don't have the authority to order 2 you to mediation. If I did, I would, but I don't. 3 So, Mr. Miller, anything you want to raise on any of these 4 cases? 5 MR. MILLER: No, your Honor. 6 THE COURT: All right. Let's pick a date when we can all 7 make it and come back on the balance. I'm looking at -- I don't 8 know what I'm going to look at. I'm going to look at the week of the 27th of January. How about the morning of the 29th? 9 10 That's a Wednesday. Nine o'clock work out okay for you, folks? 11 MR. MILLER: Sounds good to me. 12 THE COURT: All right. And some of you folks might not have 13 been here before, and I'll say this for your benefit. If you 14 have a particular issue you want to raise with me, file a case 15 management conference statement. If you don't, you don't have 16 to. I want the Plaintiffs' firm to file a case management 17 conference statement, and I want the lead defendants to file a 18 case management conference statement. The rest of you smaller 19 players, save your money and settle your case and move on, okay? 20 MS. PRZETAK: Your Honor? 21 THE COURT: Yes. 22 MS. PRZETAK: May I address one issue? This is 23 Laura Przetak from Berry & Berry. The Court's case management 24 order in these asbestos cases envisions that certain records are obtained and Plaintiffs' depositions are noticed by designated 25 26 defense counsel. 27 THE COURT: Right.

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MS. PRZETAK: And the cost for doing all of that is shared

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1 amongst the defendants who have appeared in the cases. whatever reason, oversight, this is a new county for many 2 3 defendants, not all defendants are notifying Berry & Berry that they're in individual cases filed here in Solano County. I 4 would say the only exception would be the Tiburcio matter where 5 19 defendants have told Berry & Berry they are involved in that 6 7 case, but in the remaining cases we have but two or three defendants. So, those two or three defendants will be bearing 8 the cost of all the functions that Berry & Berry performs, and 9 10 the other are not participating. 11 So, I would ask that this Court require defendants to notify 12 Berry & Berry of all the cases they're involved in here in 13 Solano County within, say, a week. 14 THE COURT: A week of today's date? 15 MS. PRZETAK: Yes, your Honor. 16 THE COURT: Anybody want to be heard on that? So ordered. 17 MS. PRZETAK: Thank you, your Honor. 18 THE COURT: And, you know, I appreciate you bringing it up. And if you have problems like that, don't hesitate to bring them 19 20 up at any time. As I said, you know, some of you folks are new to this Court. And so, I'm happy to help assist you in 21 22 resolving your cases. Some people don't want the trial court 23 involved in a settlement conference. Fine, I won't be in the 24 settlement conference; but if you have other issues with 25 production or compliance, you set up a phone conference, give 26 everybody 72 hours notice, I'll be happy to do it by phone.

I'll be happy to have you come back for a hearing on the issue

at any time. I'll be happy to meet with you folks off the

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
